Adobe FrameMaker 7.2 software offers a powerful, enterprise-class authoring and publishing solution. With its WYSIWYG, template-based environment, extensive long-document support, and new multiple undo capabilities, this tool enables scalable, single-source authoring and multi-channel publishing. Publish short documents, multi-volume books, and more in print, Adobe PDF, HTML, SGML, XML and other formats.
